

SEA ISLAND HABITAT CONSTRUCTION SITE CODE OF CONDUCT

MISSION STATEMENT:

Sea Island Habitat for Humanity Construction Site is a Christ Centered Housing Ministry that builds affordable housing for the qualified residents of the Sea Islands.

PURPOSE:

To provide volunteers the opportunity to learn construction skills at the Sea Island Habitat construction site.

EXPECTATIONS:

The Sea Island Habitat staff must maintain a safe, non-threatening environment for all volunteers and visitors on our construction sites.

Any intentional violation of building codes and code of conduct will result in the immediate removal of those involved.

Any disrespectful actions or attitudes; including profanity will not be tolerated by the SIHH staff.

No smoking or alcoholic beverages will be permitted on the construction site by volunteers and staff.

A one hour lunch break as instructed by their immediate Supervisor will be allowed.

Two five minute breaks will be allowed at 10:00AM and 2:00PM for staff.

No volunteer will leave the construction site without their supervisor's permission.

Any volunteer who refuses to work will immediately be removed from the work site.

Volunteers must be 18 years of age to operate power tools.

Volunteers must be 18 years of age to work higher than 6 feet.

Volunteers and staff must refrain from using personal cell phones during working hours.

All volunteers must be 16 years or older to work on the construction site.

ANY VIOLATION TO THE ABOVE EXPECTATIONS MUST BE REPORTED TO THE CONSTRUCTION MANAGER, AND WILL RESULT IN THE REMOVAL OF THOSE INVOLVED.
